## Canadian Financial Aid Guide

### 2010-2011

#### Exchange Rate Allowance

Kuyper College maintains a Canadian-funds exchange rate of 90%. In addition, our Canadian students benefit from a Kuyper College exchange-rate allowance: 50% of the difference between the U.S. dollar amount and the Canadian exchanged-funds amount. This allowance is credited to the student's account and can be used towards tuition, housing costs and books.

#### Endowed Scholarships

By completing the Canadian Financial Aid Application by March 1 (priority deadline), you may qualify for the following aid:

1. Canadian Grant-in-Aid (up to \$500 per year)
2. Canadian Need-based Grant (up to \$1,000 per year)
3. Institutional endowed scholarships (up to \$4,000 per year)
4. Multicultural scholarships (up to \$5,000 per year)

#### Kuyper Achievement Awards

These renewable awards are based on academic merit (GPA and ACT/SAT scores) and range from \$1,000-\$8,000 per year. The Canadian standard mark system is converted into the U.S. standard GPA system by the Kuyper College Admissions Office, and Kuyper Achievement Awards are awarded on a rolling basis soon after acceptance to the College.

\*To be considered for the Trustee Scholarship, students must be admitted to Kuyper College by January 1 and participate in the Leadership Experience Day competition on January 22.

#### Christian Leadership Scholarships

This renewable scholarship is worth \$2,000 per year and is funded by Kuyper College Alumni. It is based on academic ability (minimum GPA 3.2), Christian character, ministry experience, and potential for leadership. For consideration, all applications and references must be received by the Financial Aid Office at Kuyper College no later than February 15.

#### Christian Ministry Scholarships

This scholarship is for a dependent student who demonstrates financial need and whose family's primary source of income comes from a parent's involvement in a full-time Christian non-profit organization. For priority consideration, applications should be received by the Financial Aid Office at Kuyper College by March 1. The scholarship will be coordinated with other aid and is based on the availability of funds.

### **Sibling Scholarships**

Kuyper College will award Sibling Scholarships to students who have at least one sibling concurrently enrolled at Kuyper. Each sibling may receive up to \$500 per academic year if they are enrolled full-time, in good academic standing, and considered dependents according to the 2009-2010 Canadian Financial Aid Application. Qualified siblings should notify the Financial Aid Office of the qualifications to be considered for the scholarship.

### **Canadian Student Loan Program**

Through the Canadian Student Loan Program, loans are provided to Canadian students through their province/territory even if the student attends a college outside of Canada. A student can obtain an application kit from their high school guidance counselor, a Canadian college or university, or the Student Awards Branch of the Ministry of College and Universities within their province/territory. Please read all instructions carefully because each province/territory follows its own procedures. Kuyper College's Financial Aid Office will need to fill out a portion of the loan application in order to confirm the amount requested, enrollment status, program of study, and other various information as requested by the Canadian Government. Please turn your completed application into the Financial Aid Office as soon as possible, as the loan may take up to 10 weeks to process.

### **Student Employment Program**

### **Dual Citizenship**

If a Canadian student has citizenship in both the United States and Canada, the student is able to apply for U.S. financial aid.
