Kuyper Scholarships

Kuyper College recognizes students' academic achievement and exceptional talents through a variety of renewable merit-based and endowed scholarships. Detailed information is provided below.

Kuyper Academic Scholarships

These renewable awards are based on academic merit (cumulative marks) and range from \$1,000-\$8,000 per year. Kuyper Achievement Awards are awarded on a rolling basis soon after acceptance to the College.

Multicultural Scholarship	Academic record (minimum GPA of 2.5), leadership involvement, quality of the application essays, cross-cultural experiences, as well as the student's ethnic, cultural and socioeconomic background and ability to contribute to Kuyper's efforts to create an intercultural student body	\$500-\$5,000	\$2,000 - \$20,000	Submit an application; priority is given to students admitted by January 13 th .
Christian Ministry Scholarship	A dependent student who demonstrates financial need and whose family's primary source of income comes from a parent's employment in a full-time Christian non-profit organization	up to \$2,000	up to \$8,000	Complete Christian Ministry Application, along with Canadian Financial Aid Form, by January 13 th .
Endowed Scholarship	Awarded on basis of several criteria including financial need, career interest, academic achievement (minimum GPA of 2.0), and special status	up to \$4,000	up to \$16,000	No separate application required.
Sibling Scholarship	Awarded to siblings who are concurrently enrolled full-time, in good academic standing, and considered dependent	up to \$500	up to \$2,000	No separate application required; list siblings on application for admission.
Alumni Scholarship	Awarded to dependents of Kuyper College alumnus(a) who are enrolled full-time and in good academic standing	up to \$500	up to \$2,000	No separate application required; list parent information on application for admission.

Kuyper College Grant	Students who demonstrate a significant level of unmet need	Amount varies	Amount varies	Complete Canadian Financial Aid Application.
Church Matching Grant	A student's church may donate any amount in his or her name, and Kuyper College will match up to \$500 per year.	up to \$500	up to \$2,000	Complete Church Matching Grant Application, along with Canadian Financial Aid Form.
Canadian Grant	A Canadian student who demonstrates financial need	up to \$1,500	up to \$6,000	Complete Canadian Financial Aid Application.

Canadian Student Loan Program

Through the Canadian Student Loan Program, loans are provided to Canadian students through their province/territory even if the student attends a college outside of Canada. A student can obtain an application kit from their high school guidance counselor, a Canadian college or university, or the Student Awards Branch of the Ministry of College and Universities within their province/territory. Please read all instructions carefully because each province/territory follows its own procedures. Kuyper College's Financial Aid Office will need to fill out a portion of the loan application in order to confirm the amount requested, enrollment status, program of study, and other information as requested by the Canadian Government. Please turn your completed application in to the Financial Aid Office as soon as possible, as the loan may take up to 10 weeks to process.

Student Employment Program

Dual Citizenship

If a Canadian student has citizenship in both the United States and Canada, the student is able to apply for U.S. financial aid.
