

Christian Ministry Scholarship

The Christian Ministry Scholarship is designed to recognize the commitment of parents who work in Christian Ministry in the work of pastor, missionary or other full-time vocational Christian ministry. Awards up to \$2,000 to selected incoming dependent students demonstrating financial need. To qualify, the primary parent's income must be through a Christian non-profit organization.

QUALIFICATIONS

Recipients need to reapply for this award annually based on financial need and continued involvement in Christian service. Below is additional qualifications that you may want to consider before completing the application.

- Students must be enrolled for 12 or more credit hours (full-time) each semester.
- A minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale (Canadian marks are converted to be equivalent to the scale)
- The family's 2016 primary source of income must come from the parent's involvement in full-time ministry.
- Dependent status as defined by the FAFSA.
- A Free Application for Federal Student Aid must be filed to determine financial need.
- The scholarship will be coordinated with other aid and is based on the availability of funds.
- Students receiving a tuition waiver are not eligible for this scholarship.

APPLY TODAY

Students interested in being considered for the Christian Ministry Scholarship should have both their application for admissions and the Christian Ministry Scholarship Application submitted by January 13 in order to be assured full consideration for the scholarship.
